

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1. Do I need points for courses in CCFE? There are no points required for entry to any of our courses. Applicants are required to have their Leaving Certificate or equivalent qualification. Mature applicants may be granted exemptions. For some courses it may be necessary to present a portfolio of work. For specific course requirements see individual course pages.

2. Are there Fees for my course? In all full-time courses there is a charge of €300 for the College fee. Some courses may have additional charges for materials.

3. Grants: Students undertaking any full time Further Education course may apply for a means tested maintenance grant. Application forms are available from www.susi.ie. Students from designated disadvantaged partnership areas may be eligible for financial assistance towards course charges. Mature Students may be eligible to apply for Back to Education or VTOS grants if in receipt of Jobseeker's Benefit or Jobseeker's Allowance or signing for credits for at least 6 months (156 days) or. Getting One-Parent Family Payment, Disability Allowance, Illness Benefit or Invalidity Pension and are over 21 years of age.

4. How do I apply for a place? All of our applications are online by logging on to www.Crumlincollege.ie and completing an online application form. Once Applicants have applied they will receive a conditional letter of offer for their chosen course. This offer is subject to applicants satisfying course minimum entry requirements and availability of places.

4. How can I pay my Fees? To pay your course fees online, click on the Register / Pay Fees button on the Crumlin College website to log in to the college applications system. Select the Payments tab to see the breakdown of your fees and to make a payment. All fees must be paid in full by the last banking day in September. 5. Which campus will my classes take place be in? The main campus is located at Crumlin Road campus and in general, this is also the base for most classes. Beauty courses are mostly based in our Captains Road campus. Some practical Sports classes take place in our Clogher Road campus.

6. Can International Students apply? The following International students can apply for a course

- EU citizens
- International Students in possession of a stamp 4, 5 or 6
- Applicants who are in the international protection system who have permission to work are entitled to access VTOS programmes
